# Park Rules for the Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg

**The Forest Adventure Park, opened in April 2010, gives all ages an outdoor experience.**

Our state-of-the-art belay system is regularly maintained, but we also need your help. If you concentrate on what you are doing and handle the belay devices with care, you will get the most out of your experience in our Forest Adventure Park. Please take care of yourself and follow our signs, safety instructions, the General Terms and Conditions, and the following Park Rules. **Please talk to your children and explain these rules in great detail.**

- After you have left the ground you must remain attached to the safety system as it was explained at the safety briefing. The management reserves the right to ask anyone in breach of these rules to leave the Forest Adventure Park. Any further claims for damages shall remain unaffected hereby.
- Climbing is a high risk activity. It is crucial that you act in a responsible and considerate way. The Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg will not be liable for any injuries, which could be fatal, caused by ropes, branches, roots, inappropriate handling, and breach of rules, willful misconduct or gross negligence. Climbing in the Forest Adventure Park is at your own risk.
- Every climber or guardian must read and understand the Park Rules before starting to climb in the Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg.
- Do not smoke after you have put on the climbing harness. The safety system is made of plastic which can easily be damaged by fire or flying sparks. Do not get close to open fires or glowing embers. Keep a distance of at least 16 feet. Anyone who damages the safety system is held liable.
- Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs impairing reaction and coordination are not allowed to climb in the Forest Adventure Park.
- Persons with any physical or mental impairment must report their condition to the instructor.
- For hygienic reasons, please take off your harness before you use the toilet. Upon returning, please ask one of the instructors to fit your harness again.
- Our well trained instructors will give every participant a safety briefing (theory and practice). It is mandatory to attend this safety briefing!
- For your own protection, please tie up long hair. Piercings have to be removed or taped over.
- For safety reasons, all participants have to wear only the certified safety system of the Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg. This safety system is your personal protection against falling down and should not be given to other persons at any time during your stay at the Forest Adventure Park.
- Do not carry any objects with you (jewelry, phones, cameras, or water bottles etc.). Please do not use your mobile phones while on the premises.
- After your safety briefing, you can stay on the premises for three hours.
- If you finish earlier or if you have to finish earlier due to thunderstorms, storms, or fire, you are not entitled for a reimbursement of the entrance fee.
- All instructions given by the staff of the Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg are binding. These instructions keep you safe.
- On the courses, children from 8 to 13 years have to be supervised by **one participating adult**, children from 6 to 7 years by **two participating adults**. School classes and groups of children can either climb with one adult supervising 5 children from 8 to 13 years or hire additional security personnel.

**Children older than 14 years can only climb on their own with the consent of one parent.**

With your approval of these Park Rules you certify that you have no medical concerns which may prevent you from taking part in a climbing activity where you are responsible for your own safety. In case of doubt, you should ask a doctor before starting to climb. By signing the Acknowledgment Notice below, you also certify that you have carefully read and fully understood the terms of these Park Rules and that you accept them. With your signature, you also accept the General Terms and Conditions of the Forest Adventure Park Herrenberg.

**Children and young adults under 18 need the written consent of a guardian or a supervisor.**
